Bay Ridge Connects is a storefront community center for adults aged 60+ in Brooklyn's Bay Ridge neighborhood. It is an outgrowth of the Bay Ridge Center (BRC), which has been an anchor for the local senior community for more than forty years. Although affiliated with BRC, this second, store-front location offers a unique opportunity to embrace new programming and engage a wider and more diverse population. WHAT IS THE AGE FRIENDLY MOVEMENT?

Did you know that in 2018, the amount of people in the United States that were 65 and over was at 52 million, making up 16% of the population? This number is expected to skyrocket to 95 million by 2060, making it that people 65 years and older make up 23% of the population.

Bay Ridge Center and Bay Ridge Connects, in cooperation with Community Board 10, are spearheading a movement to make our neighborhood of Bay Ridge more senior accessible by incorporating initiatives established as part of the Age Friendly NYC Campaign.

Age Friendly NYC is a collaborative effort established by the City of New York Academy of Medicine to respond to the graying of our communities by activating an “age-in-everything” lens across all aspects of city life and asking the city’s public agencies, businesses, cultural, educational and religious institutions, community groups and individuals to consider how changes to policy and practice can create a city more inclusive of older adults and more sensitive to their needs.

Through subsequent meetings and focus groups Age Friendly Bay Ridge is working to identify initiatives that will impact seniors in significant ways and consider how best to serve and benefit from Bay Ridge’s growing senior population. We have already identified transportation, quality of life issues, increased senior housing options and senior safety concerns as areas on which we would like to focus Age Friendly Bay Ridge initiatives.
